Chris Gotterup (Winner/-22)

- First PGA TOUR title in his 27th start at 24 years, 9 months, 22 days; previous best finish: T4/2022 John Deere Classic
- Earns 300 FedExCup points (moves from No. 149 to No. 69) and is fully exempt through the 2026 PGA TOUR Season; qualifies for next week's PGA Championship, his second major championship appearance (2022 U.S. Open/T43), as well as The Sentry and THE PLAYERS Championship in 2025
- Six strokes is the largest margin of victory on TOUR this season (previous: 5, Scottie Scheffler/Arnold Palmer Invitational presented by Mastercard); largest margin of victory by a first-time winner on TOUR since Lee Hodges (2023 3M Open/7 strokes)
- Seventh first-time winner on TOUR this season and second in as many weeks (Taylor Pendrith/THE CJ CUP Byron Nelson)
- First player to bogey the first two holes of the final round and win on TOUR since Keith Mitchell (2019 Cognizant Classic in The Palm Beaches)
- 262 marks career-low 72-hole total (previous: 267, 2022 John Deere Classic/T4)
- Led the field in Total Birdies this week (28)
- Moves to No. 1 in the Aon Swing 5; the top five players, not otherwise exempt, who earn the most FedExCup points during the Myrtle Beach Classic, Charles Schwab Challenge and RBC Canadian Open will qualify for the next Signature Event at the Memorial Tournament presented by Workday

Miscellaneous Notes

- In his second career PGA TOUR start, sponsor exemption **Alistair Docherty** (T2/-16) posts a final-round 64 and finishes runner-up to qualify for the next open PGA TOUR tournament at the RBC Canadian Open; has conditional status on the Korn Ferry Tour in 2024 and has made seven starts this season (best: T20/LECOM Suncoast Classic)
- Davis Thompson (T2/-16) collects his second career runner-up finish on TOUR and first top-10 since the 2023 American Express (2nd)
- Thorbjørn Olesen (T16/-12) sets the new course record at The Dunes Golf and Beach Club with a 61 (previous: 63, Jay Sigel/1994 Charles Schwab Cup Championship/R4; Trace Crowe/2024 Myrtle Beach Classic/R2); marks his career-low round on TOUR (previous: 64/2018 WGC-Bridgestone Invitational/R4, 2015 WGC-HSBC Champions/R1)
- 16-year-old **Blades Brown** (T26/-10), who became the second 16-year-old in as many weeks to make the cut on the PGA TOUR (Kris Kim/THE CJ CUP Byron Nelson/65th), finishes T26 in his TOUR debut
