Today – A weakening complex of showers/T-storms will overspread Myrtle Beach, mainly before 10am. Additional showers/T-storms are possible this afternoon but will be contingent on instability rebuilding behind the morning activity. South/southwest winds will increase behind the early afternoon sea breeze with gusts over 20 mph possible. Forecast rainfall: 0.25-0.50" with locally higher amounts in T-storms. **Sunrise: 6:18am / Sunset: 8:05pm**
