Today – Areas of rain will continue through the morning hours with a slight chance of embedded thunderstorms. The steady rain will become more scattered as we go through the afternoon with thunderstorms becoming more likely with the heating of the day. Rainfall could be heavy at times, especially with thunderstorms. Otherwise, temperatures in the 60s will gradually warm into the low to mid 70s this afternoon.

Extended forecast – Morning fog will be likely to start the day Saturday before burning-off and allowing partly cloudy skies to return. Scattered showers and thunderstorms will be possible during the afternoon, but the higher likelihood is trending further to east. High pressure will begin to build into the region Sunday into Monday providing warm and humid conditions. Highs will likely reach the mid-80s Sunday and upper 80s on Monday with partly to mostly sunny skies.
