Today – Areas of fog may develop around daybreak that could linger through around 9am before burning-off. Otherwise, partly to mostly cloudy skies can be expected today with highs warming to around 80 degrees. A complex of rain and storms will weaken as it moves east across Missouri into Illinois during the afternoon. A passing light shower may be possible between 5pm-7pm if this activity can hold together. Most locations will remain rain free today before showers and thunderstorms arrive after midnight.

Partly cloudy skies and dry weather returns Sunday into Monday with highs in the mid-80s.
