- 2** 2015 FedExCup champion Jordan Spieth is one of two past FedExCup champions in the field (Snedeker/2012)
- 236** Spieth is 236 under par in the State of Texas, 19 strokes better than next best (Matt Kuchar/-217)
- 77 / 4.46** Since 2010, Jordan Spieth has 77 rounds of 69 or better and a 4.46 birdie average in the Lone Star State, ranking First and T2 among players with at least 25 rounds in Texas PGA TOUR events. Spieth has the most top-five finishes of any player in Texas in this span with nine.

- 176th** in the FedExCup this season, marking Villegas' third worse rank with 14 weeks left in the regular season
- 70.0** Mackenzie Hughes scoring average in first two rounds this season and on pace for career-low in a single season. Hughes has opened each of last four starts under par in Round One.
- 57th** in FedExCup standings, the highest ranked Canadian in the field this week
