Today –Partly to mostly cloudy skies can be expected this morning as showers and storms will remain north and east of the DFW area. Cannot rule out an isolated shower or thunderstorm developing during the afternoon, but most locations will remain dry. The higher chances will be later this evening into tonight as storms develop over West Texas and move eastward. Heavy rain, gusty winds will be possible with these storms.

Extended forecast – A cold front will settle southward bringing a good chance for showers and thunderstorms Saturday afternoon. Storms could be strong with gusty winds and heavy rainfall. There will likely be a lull in the precipitation late in the day Saturday before another complex of storms moves east from west Texas. This will likely roll through the DFW area late Saturday night into Sunday morning with another round of heavy rain and gusty winds. The forecast will begin to settle down on Monday with only a slight chance of showers and thunderstorms is expected during the afternoon.
