Today –A boundary from storms in Oklahoma will move south and be a focus for scattered showers and a few thunderstorms over North Texas as we reach late morning into the early afternoon hours. This activity will likely taper-off by late afternoon with only a slight chance for a shower or thunderstorm expected into the evening hours. Rain and storms will become likely after midnight as a complex moves east across the region.

Extended forecast — The complex of heavy rain and thunderstorms will be shifting east by Sunday morning with a lull in the precipitation expected. Scattered showers and a few thunderstorms could redevelop during the afternoon if the atmosphere can recover. Otherwise, the forecast will begin to settle down on Monday but the chance for scattered showers and thunderstorms is will possible during the afternoon. Hot temperatures can be expected Tuesday with highs in the upper 80s.
