Today – The complex of rain and thunderstorms has pushed east leaving cloudy skies over the region this morning. Skies will become mostly cloudy to partly cloudy as we go through midday into the afternoon. Cannot rule out an isolated shower or thunderstorm redeveloping during the afternoon, but most locations will remain rain free for the rest of the day. Temperatures in the 60s this morning will warm into the upper 70s by late in the day.
