Today –The rain will be ending by 6am with a few lingering showers possible through mid-morning. Otherwise, cloudy skies will give way to partly sunny skies this afternoon with temperatures warming to around 80 degrees. The higher likelihood will be later tonight as another complex of strong to severe storms develops to the west and moves across the DFW area.

Extended forecast – Thunderstorms will be possible again early Friday morning as a cold front settles into the region. Storms could be strong to severe with heavy rain and strong gusty winds. The frontal boundary will stall across N. Texas into Saturday keeping the chance for scattered showers and thunderstorms in the forecast. A better chance for thunderstorms can be expected Sunday as upper-level energy passes over the region and enhances the instability. Heavy rain and strong storms will be a possibility as well.
