## **Players to Watch**

- Matthew Anderson (Canada) Won last week's 69th ECP Brazil Open and moved to No. 1 in the Fortinet Cup standings; has posted eight consecutive rounds of par or better, tied with Joey Vrzich and Devon Bling for the longest active streak on Tour
- José de Jesús Rodríguez (Mexico) Won the Totalplay Championship at Atlas Country Club and is currently No. 2 in the Fortinet Cup; competed in the Diners Club Peru Open on PGA TOUR Latinoamérica four times (Best: T12/2016)
- Clay Feagler (United States) Won the season-opening Bupa Championship at Tulum and is No. 3 in the Fortinet Cup; one of 16 players who have made the cut in all three events this season
- **Joseph Winslow (United States)** Leads the Tour with a 66.33 scoring average; enters the week T18 in the Fortinet Cup
- Julián Etulain (Argentina) Won the Diners Club Peru Open twice when it was a PGA TOUR Latinoamérica event (2013, 2014); finished third at the Bupa Championship at Tulum and currently No. 8 in the Fortinet Cup
- Luis Fernando Barco (Peru) One of five Peruvian players in the field; has two made cuts this season (Best: T20/Totalplay Championship at Atlas Country Club) and currently 53rd in the Fortinet Cup

• Julian Perico (Peru) – From Lima, Peru and playing on a sponsor exemption; graduated from the University of Arkansas in 2023, where he won twice and finished with the second-lowest career scoring average in program history

#### **Tournament History**

Los Inkas Golf Club hosted the PGA TOUR Latinoamérica Diners Club Peru Open 10 times (2012-19, 2022-23). This week's field includes four players who won the PGA TOUR Latinoamérica event: Marcos Montenegro (2023), Leandro Marelli (2019), Rodolfo Cazaubòn (2015), and Julián Etulain (2013, 2014).

#### **Fortinet Cup Overview**

The Diners Club Peru Open is the fourth of six events in the Latin America Swing, and the 141-player field features all three of the season's tournament winners, as well as 50 of the top 60 players in the Fortinet Cup.

After the season's sixth event (Inter Rapidisimo Golf Championship, May 16-19), the top 60 players in the Fortinet Cup will be exempt into the 10-event North America Swing, which begins June 20-23 with The Beachlands Victoria Open presented by Times Colonist.

#### PGA TOUR Americas – 2024 Season Summary

Up to 15 Korn Ferry Tour cards are on the line during the 2024 PGA TOUR Americas season – five conditional memberships will go to the top players from the Latin America (2) and North America (3) Swings, and the top 10 players in the season-long Fortinet Cup points list will earn exempt membership.
