Things to Know

- With Sunday's final round canceled due to continued inclement weather, **Scott Dunlap** is declared the winner of the 2024 Insperity Invitational after producing scores of 65-70—135 (-9) on Saturday. When severe storms resulted in the postponement of Friday's first round, all players completed 36 holes Saturday.
- 2022 and 2023 Insperity Invitational champion **Steven Alker** finishes T4 at 7-under 137 in his bid to become the first player to win the same PGA TOUR Champions event three consecutive seasons since Bernhard Langer at the Kaulig Companies Championship (2014-2016).
- In his first start since tearing his Achilles on February 1, World Golf Hall of Fame member and 4-time Insperity Invitational winner **Bernhard Langer** claims T31 honors at 1-under 143 after rounds of 69-74.

Scott Dunlap, 65-70—135 (-9)

- Followed a first-round 7-under 65 Saturday morning with a 2-under 70 in round two Saturday afternoon, good for a 1-stroke victory at 9-under 135.
- With the victory, he claims his second career PGA TOUR Champions title in 10 years and 191 starts after winning the 2014 Boeing Classic.
- The 1985 University of Florida grad claims the victory at the age of 60 years, 8 months, 20 days in his 207th start.
- The win marks his 39th top-10 finish and is his first since a T4 at the 2023 Shaw Charity Classic.
- Coming into the week, he had just one sub-par score in his first seven rounds this season; including this week's two rounds, he has now posted sub-par scores in seven of the eight rounds since.
- On the PGA TOUR, he claimed 13 top-10 finishes in 204 starts, highlighted by three third-place showings.

Other Notes

• With bogey-free rounds of 69-67—136 (-8) Saturday, **Stuart Appleby** claims a share of second place; in two previous Insperity Invitational starts, he finished T14 in 2022 and T30 last year; lone top-10 finish in seven starts

- this season, a T7, came two weeks ago at the Invited Celebrity Classic, which was also reduced to 36 holes (inclement weather).
- Having not cracked the top-30 in his last three starts since winning the Cologuard Classic, **Joe Durant** posts back-to-back 4-under 68s to claim T2 honors with Appleby at 8-under 136; lone top-10 finish in eight previous starts in the Insperity Invitational was T4 in his first start of 2015.
- After opening with a bogey-free 6-under 66 Saturday morning, Thailand's **Thongchai Jaidee** signed for a 1-under 71, good for a T4 finish at 7-under 137; in his only previous Insperity Invitational start, finished T48 in 2023.
