#### Things to Know

- In his sixth start since returning from last year's season-ending elbow injury, 54-hole co-leader **Doug Barron** closed with bogey-free 68 to win the Regions Tradition.

#### Doug Barron, 65-72-66-68 – 271 (-17)

- The 54-year-old earned his third win on PGA TOUR Champions (82 starts)
  - 2019 DICK'S Open
  - 2021 Rogers Charity Classic
  - 2024 Regions Tradition
- This was his sixth start since returning from an elbow injury that sidelined him from April 2023 to March 2024
- Earned his first major title on PGA TOUR Champions (11 major starts)
  - Previous best finish in a senior major: T3 (2022 Senior Open Championship presented by Rolex)
- Moves up to No. 5 in the Charles Schwab Cup standings after earning his first win of the 2024 season (six starts)
  - Previous best finish in 2024: T2 (Mitsubishi Electric Classic)
- Matched his low 72-hole score on PGA TOUR Champions (271)
  - Previous instance: 2021 Charles Schwab Cup Championship
- Making his third appearance at the Regions Tradition, his previous finishes were T19 (2021) and T9 (2022)
- Improved to 3-for-6 when leading/co-leading entering the final round on PGA TOUR Champions

#### Other Notes

- Charles Schwab Cup leader **Steven Alker** carded the low round of the week with 9-under 63 to finish 2nd at 15-under. His 63 matched the low 18-hole score at the Regions Tradition since it moved to Greystone Golf & Country Club in 2016 (previous instance: Robert Karlsson, 2023, 3rd Round). This is Alker's fourth top-2 finish of the 2024 season (eight starts).
  - Note: the low 18-hole score in Regions Tradition history is 62 (three times)
- **Stewart Cink** closed with bogey-free 66 to finish T3 at 14-under. He matched his best finish on PGA TOUR Champions (eight starts).
  - Previous instance: 2023 KitchenAid Senior PGA Championship (3rd)

- In his bid for a three-peat at the Regions Tradition, 36-hole leader **Steve Stricker** carded 69 to finish T3 at 14-under. It was his sixth consecutive top-3 finish at the Regions Tradition.
  - Stricker's last six appearances at the Regions Tradition: T2 (2018), Won (2019), 2nd (2021), Won (2022), Won (2023), T3 (2024)
- 54-hole co-leader **Ernie Els** finished T3 at 14-under after shooting 71 in the final round. The World Golf Hall of Fame member has finished in the top 4 in each of his four appearances at the Regions Tradition.
  - Els at the Regions Tradition: T4 (2021), T3 (2022), T2 (2023), T3 (2024)
- **Charlie Wi** and **K.J. Choi** each finished T6 at 11-under.
- 2024 World Golf Hall of Fame inductee **Padraig Harrington**, 2014 champion **Kenny Perry** and two-time champion (2016, 2017) **Bernhard Langer** each finished T8 at 10-under. Langer, a member of the World Golf Hall of Fame, was making his second start since returning from an Achilles injury.
