## TIGER WOODS

### Arnold Palmer Invitational presented by MasterCard

#### HIGHLIGHTS

Earns his 66th career PGA TOUR victory at the age of 33 years, 2 months and 29 days in his 239<sup>th</sup> (225<sup>th</sup> professional) career start on TOUR. The 66 victories are third all-time on the PGA TOUR behind Sam Snead (82) and Jack Nicklaus (73).

#### All-time PGA TOUR Victories:

- 1) Sam Snead – 82; won 66<sup>th</sup> (1952 All American Open) at the age of 40 years, 2 months, 6 days
- 2) Jack Nicklaus – 73; won 66<sup>th</sup> (1978 THE PLAYERS) at the age of 38 years, 1 month, 29 days
- 3) Tiger Woods – 66; won 66<sup>th</sup> (2009 Arnold Palmer Invitational) at the age of 33 years, 2 months and 29 days

Earned 500 FedExCup points to move to 12th in the FedExCup standings with 622 points.

#### ARNOLD PALMER INVITATIONAL NOTES

First player to win six Arnold Palmer Invitational titles. The only other players with multiple victories at the event are Tom Kite (1982 and 1989) and Loren Roberts (1994-95).

#### CAREER NOTES

Four of last eight PGA TOUR wins have come on par-70 golf courses (2007 PGA Championship, 2007 TOUR Championship, 2008-2009 Arnold Palmer Invitational).

Matches largest comeback after 54 holes (5 strokes) with victory at the Arnold Palmer Invitational. Also came back from 5 strokes after 54-hole to win the 2000 AT&T Pebble Beach National Pro-Am (Mark Brooks and Matt Gogel).

Last 54-hole comeback was at the 2007 BMW Championship where he came from one stroke behind Steve Stricker and Aaron Baddeley to win.

Out of Tiger Woods' 66 career wins, he has now come from behind to win 19 times.
