7:00AM Weather Update: Thursday, March 26, 2009



Synopsis: High pressure anchored over the Southeastern U.S. will continue to dominate Central Florida's weather. Partly cloudy skies can be expected today with highs in the low 80's. A cold front will stall across Southern Georgia and Alabama tomorrow. This may be close enough to produce isolated showers and t-storms to areas north of Orlando on Friday. But should be a dry day for most locations. A stronger cold front will approach Central Florida late Saturday night and slowly move southeast of Orlando during the morning hours on Sunday. This will keep the chance for showers in the forecast through late morning on Sunday. Clearing skies can be expected for the afternoon.

Winds: SE 10-20 with gusts to 25 mph
