7:00AM Weather Update: Friday, March 27, 2009



Synopsis: Another t-storm complex is moving into the Florida Panhandle this morning. This activity should remain north of Orlando today. Mainly high clouds will stream over the area from these storms. There could be an isolated shower or t-storm that develops this afternoon along the sea breeze. The best chance of this happening will be north of the area. Another strong cold front will move into the Florida Panhandle late tomorrow afternoon and then slowly move southeast across Central Florida. The best chance for showers and isolated t-storms will occur Sunday morning through the early afternoon. Then clearing skies and less humid air returns for the rest of the day.

Today:

9AM: A mix of sun and high clouds.
Temp: 66F RH: 78%
Winds: S 10-15 mph

Noon: Considerable cloudiness and breezy.
Temp: 79F RH: 54%
Winds: S 10-20mph

3PM: Considerable cloudiness and breezy. Slight chance of a shower.
Temp: 82F RH: 46%
Winds: S 10-20 mph

Extended Outlook:

Sat: Partly cloudy, breezy and hot...a slight chance of a shower or t-storm late in the day.
Low: 67F High: 89F
Winds: S 15-20 mph with higher gusts

Sun: Mostly cloudy with a chance of showers and isolated t-storms through early afternoon. Clearing skies the rest of the day. Chance of precipitation 50%.
Low: 68F High: 78F
Winds: SW shifting W 10-20 mph
