7:45AM Weather Update: Saturday, March 28, 2009



Synopsis: Partly cloudy, windy and hot conditions can be expected today as a strong cold front moves across the Deep South. Southerly winds of 15-25 with gusts to 30 mph will help temperatures warm to near 90 degrees this afternoon. There could be an isolated shower or t-storm that develops late this afternoon. Otherwise, most areas will remain dry. The cold front will approach Central Florida late tonight and slowly move southeast through the area late Sunday morning. This will push a line of showers and t-storms across the area during this time. Some of these storms could be severe with damaging winds. Clearing skies can be expected during the afternoon with cooler temperatures.

9AM: Partly cloudy and breezy.
Temp: 70F RH: 87%
Winds: S 10-15 mph

Noon: Partly cloudy and windy.
Temp: 81F RH: 60%
Winds: S 15-25 gusting to 30mph

3PM: Partly cloudy and windy. Slight chance of a shower or t-storm.
Temp: 88F RH: 46%
Winds: S 15-25 gusting to 30mph

Extended Outlook:

Sun: Mostly cloudy with showers and isolated t-storms through early afternoon. Clearing skies the rest of the day. Chance of precipitation 60%.
Low: 70F High: 77F
Winds: SW shifting W 10-20 mph
