7:00AM Weather Update: Wednesday, March 25, 2009



Synopsis: High pressure anchored over the Eastern U.S. will continue to dominate Central Florida's weather over the next few days. Partly cloudy skies and breezy conditions can be expected. Temperatures in the upper 70's today will warm into the upper 80's to near 90 degrees by Saturday. A cold front will bring the chance for showers and t-storms Saturday night through Sunday morning. Clearing skies and cooler temperatures will return for the afternoon.
