

HP Byron Nelson Championship 2009 FedExCup Notes – Week 20

Changes at the Top

- Zach Johnson's victory at the Valero Texas Open moved him ahead of Geoff Ogilvy at the top of the standings by 94 points.
- Currently in third place in the standings, Phil Mickelson is only 148 points behind Zach Johnson and could pass Johnson at the top if he finishes third or better this week.
- There are 25 players this week who can move into the top 10 in the standings, but 20 of them will have to win to do it.
- At 50th in the standings, Bob Estes is the lowest ranked player who could move into the top 10 this week. Players currently outside of the top 50 that need to make a move soon include: Anthony Kim (51st), Robert Allenby (56th), Stuart Appleby (114th), Vijay Singh (98th), and Adam Scott (69th),

FedExCup Player of the Week – Ian Poulter
