

HP Byron Nelson Championship 7AM Weather Update Thursday May 21, 2009



Synopsis: Mostly sunny skies, light winds, and pleasant temperatures are forecast today. Today's high is forecast in the mid 80s with east/southeast winds at 5-10mph. A low pressure system in the Gulf of Mexico will push some moisture in our direction over the next few days and will increase our humidity levels and cloud cover. We should hang onto another dry day Friday, but scattered showers and thunderstorms will be possible on Saturday and Sunday. Seasonal temperatures are forecast through the weekend with morning lows in the mid 60s and afternoon highs in the low to mid 80s.
