7AM Weather Update Friday May 22, 2009



Synopsis: Warm and muggy conditions are forecast today with afternoon temps climbing into the mid 80s. There will be more clouds in the area today and an isolated shower can not be completely ruled out later in the afternoon. Thunderstorm chances have increased for Saturday and Sunday as the low pressure system over the Gulf of Mexico pushes additional moisture in our direction. Temperatures will remain mild through the weekend with highs reaching the lower 80s each day.
