FedExCup Field Notes

- There are five of the top-10 and 14 of the top-30 players in the FedExCup rankings teeing it up this week.
- All 14 players entering in the to-30 could move to the top of the FedExCup standings with a victory.
- The five players in the top-10 could move to the top with a second place finish.
- Three players could move into the top-10 with a third place finish.
- Kenny Perry could move into first place in the standings with a top-25 finish.

FedExCup Quick Fact

Nick Watney is the only player in the top-10 in the FedExCup standings who is also in the top-10 on the PGA TOUR in driving distance.
