Final-Round Notes – Sunday, February 15, 2009

Weather: Isolated thunderstorms. High in the upper 50s. Winds S-SE 30-40 mph with gusts up to 60 mph.

The final-round was officially postponed at 1:00 p.m. PT on Sunday due to weather. The start of the final round has been rescheduled for 7:30 a.m. on Monday. Amateurs were excused when the three-hour delay was announced.

Golf Channel will pick up the final round of play on Monday from 12:30 p.m. PT until its finish.

Weather Related Facts:

Last 54-hole event: 2005 BellSouth Classic

Last time full final round played Monday (unscheduled): 2005 BellSouth Classic (54-hole event)

Last time tournament canceled and not rescheduled: 1996 AT&T Pebble Beach National Pro-Am.

Last time final round postponed and played later in season: 1998 AT&T Pebble Beach National Pro-Am.

Since 1958, the AT&T Pebble Beach National Pro-Am has been shortened to 54 holes on five occasions and in 1996 it was canceled due to unplayable conditions. From 1947-57 the AT&T Pebble Beach was a 54-hole event.

The highest final-round score by a PGA TOUR winner since 1970 is 77 by Fred Couples at the 1983 Kemper Open and Lon Hinkle at the 1979 AT&T Pebble Beach National Pro-Am.

The team of Dustin Johnson/Joe Rice tied Chris Stroud/Ron Christman in the Pro-Am portion of the tournament at 23-under 193, as the Pro-Am was shortened to 54 holes. Christman is from Kingwood, TX and plays out of Deerwood Golf Club, while Rice is from Charleston, SC and plays out of Bulls Bay Golf Club.
