Rookie Performance

- There are 28 rookies on the PGA TOUR in 2009.
- 17 rookies have earned points through the first four events.
- 11 rookies are ranked in the top-125 of the FedExCup points standings.
- Scott Piercy and Webb Simpson are the highest ranked rookies at 16th and 17th, respectively, and are among the six players that could move atop the FedExCup standings with a victory this week.
