FedExCup Field Notes

- 21 of the top-30 players in the FedExCup rankings are teeing it up this week – including all of the top eight.
- 26 players currently in the field could move to the top of the FedExCup standings with a victory.
- The eight players in the top-10 could move to the top with a second place finish.
- Seven players could move into the top-10 with a third place finish.
- Three players are within 42 points of the leader.
