



# Northern Trust Open

## 6AM Weather Update Friday Feb 20, 2009



**Synopsis:** Mostly sunny skies and warm afternoon temperatures are expected today with a high in the lower 70s. Light northeast winds this morning are forecast to shift to the southwest at 6-12mph by this afternoon. Thin high level clouds will increase across the area on Saturday, but enough sun will still get through to allow temperatures to reach the lower 70s once again. Clouds look to thicken up across southern California by Sunday ahead of an approaching frontal boundary. The bulk of the rainfall is forecast to remain to our north on Sunday, but there is still a slight chance of a light shower here by late in the day.
