



Northern Trust Open

7AM Weather Update Saturday Feb 21, 2009



Synopsis: Thin high level clouds will increase across the area today, but enough sun will still get through to allow temperatures to climb to near 70 degrees. Light northeast winds this morning are forecast to shift to the southwest at 6-12mph by noon. Clouds look to thicken up across southern California by Sunday ahead of an approaching frontal boundary. The bulk of the rainfall is forecast to remain to our north on Sunday, but there is still a slight chance of a light shower here by late in the day.
