

Shell Houston Open 7AM Weather Update Thursday April 2, 2009



Synopsis: A fast moving cold front will push through the area this morning. A line of thunderstorms has developed along this front and will likely impact the course between 7am and 10am. Clearing skies are forecast by this afternoon with gusty winds developing. Winds will shift to the west/northwest by noon and could gust to 30mph at times. High pressure returns to the state on Friday resulting in mostly sunny skies, light winds, and pleasant afternoon temperatures. Another front is forecast to push across the state on Sunday which will bring a slight chance of thunderstorms to the area on Sunday morning.
