

# Shell Houston Open 7AM Weather Update Friday April 3, 2009



**Synopsis:** High pressure will result in sunny skies, light winds, and comfortable afternoon temperatures today. Cool morning temperatures will warm quickly reaching the mid 70s by this afternoon. Saturday's forecast calls for warm and humid conditions with an afternoon high near 80 degrees. Winds will increase out of the south/southeast at 12-22mph on Saturday. A cold front is expected to push across eastern Texas on Sunday morning and could produce a few scattered thunderstorms Sunday morning, and gusty winds on Sunday afternoon.

## Shell Houston Open 7AM Weather Update Saturday April 4, 2009



**Synopsis:** Partly cloudy, warm, and humid today with an afternoon high near 80 degrees. Southeast winds at 8-15mph this morning are expected to increase to 15-25mph by this afternoon. A cold front is forecast to arrive on Sunday morning and could produce a shower or two before noon. Skies will clear behind the front and winds will substantially increase. Northwest winds sustained at 15-25mph could gust to 30mph at times on Sunday afternoon.
