



2009 Mayakoba Golf Classic at Riviera Maya-Cancun

Weather: Mostly cloudy with afternoon high in the low 80s. Winds W-NW 8-15 mph.

Mark Wilson finished at 13-under par 267 to earn his second career PGA TOUR victory by two strokes over J.J. Henry.

Mark Wilson's win today (March 1, 2009) at the Mayakoba Golf Classic comes almost two years to the day of his first PGA TOUR victory at the Honda Classic on March 4, 2007.

Mark Wilson's 20 birdies this week ties Fred Funk for second behind Brian Gay's tournament record 23 in 2008.

Below are Mark Wilson's statistics for this week at the Mayakoba Golf Classic. Wilson now ranks 101st on the PGA TOUR in Putts Per Round and is T116 on the TOUR in Putting Average.

J.J. Henry shot a 11-under 269 to finish 2nd, which is his best finish since the 2006 season when he won the Buick Championship and finished T2 at the FBR Open.

Kevin Streelman turned in the round of the day with a six-under 64 to finish a career-best T3 at 10-under 270. Streelman's previous career-best finish was a T4 at The Barclays in 2008. Prior to today, Streelman's best final-round score was a 66 at the 2008 Buick Open.

Heath Slocum finished T3 at 10-under 270 to earn his best finish since a T2 at the 2007 PODS Championship. Slocum has missed three of five cuts this season to go with a T54 at the 50th Bob Hope Classic and a T3 today.

El Camaleón Golf Club, designed by 2009 Presidents Cup International Team Captain Greg Norman, was ranked No. 14 among most-difficult courses on the PGA TOUR in 2008 (71.00). The par-4 third hole (462 yards) was ranked 22nd among the toughest holes on TOUR last year (4.385). Below are overall scoring averages and the scoring average for the 3rd hole.

There are several Mexican and Spanish players in the field this year. Leading the contingent is Spaniard Jose Manuel Lara, who finished T13 with a six-under 274.
