7AM Weather Update Thursday December 3, 2009



Synopsis: It will become mostly cloudy today with the threat for showers and thunderstorms increasing by mid to late morning through the afternoon. The chance of rain is 60%. High temperatures will warm into the lower 80s. Winds will be out of the south-southwest 7-15 mph with gusts up to 20 mph. Unsettled weather continues for Friday and Saturday as a frontal boundary remains stalled across the Florida peninsula. Improved conditions are expected for Sunday and Monday.
