

# The Presidents Cup

## 8AM Weather Update: Thursday, October 8, 2009



**Synopsis:** Weak on-shore flow will continue to provide low clouds and patchy fog over the next few mornings. The cloud cover will begin to break some along the coast to allow for some peaks of sunshine this afternoon. But, temperatures will remain on the cool side with highs in the upper 50's to low 60's. Away from the coast, sunny skies can be expected today with highs in the mid to upper 60's. This weather pattern will continue through Saturday with similar conditions. Partly cloudy skies and slightly warmer temperatures can be expected for Sunday's final round.

Temp: 55F RH:85%  
Winds: SW 4-8 mph

Noon: Mostly cloudy and cool.  
Temp: 57F RH: 74%  
Winds: WSW 5-15 mph

3PM: A mix of sun and clouds.  
Temp: 58F RH: 72%  
Winds: WSW 5-15 mph
