7AM Weather Update: Thursday, April 16, 2009



**Synopsis:** High pressure building south will provide breezy and cooler temperatures through Friday. NE winds of 10-20 mph will hold temperatures in the upper 60's today and tomorrow. Gusty winds will make it feel cooler at times as well. Temperatures should warm back into the low 70's on Saturday as the high shifts east into the Atlantic. A low pressure system will approach the region from the west on Sunday. This will produce mostly cloudy skies throughout the day with a slight chance of showers or t-storms possible by evening.
