7:30AM Weather Update: Saturday, April 18, 2009



Synopsis: High pressure over the area will slowly shift east into the Atlantic today. This will provide sunny skies with a little warmer temperatures. The winds will remain light this morning and shift out of the SE 10-15 mph by early afternoon. This will knock the temperatures from the low 70's into the upper 60's for the rest of the day. A low pressures system and associated cold front will approach the area from the west on Sunday. Partly cloudy skies can be expected for the morning hours with skies becoming mostly cloudy during the afternoon. Looks like any showers or t-storm activity will hold off until Sunday night into Monday morning.
