7:30AM Weather Update: Sunday, April 19, 2009



Synopsis: High pressure over the Atlantic will provide one more dry day before a cold front approaches the area from the west. Partly cloudy skies this morning will slowly become mostly cloudy this afternoon. Temperatures should warm into the mid 70's before the sea breeze knocks the temperatures down into the upper 60's this afternoon. Looks like the best chance for shower or t-storm activity will hold off until late tonight into Monday morning.
