7AM Weather Update: Friday, April 17, 2009



Synopsis: High pressure building south will provide another breezy and cool day today. Temperatures should warm into the mid to upper 60's this afternoon under sunny skies. A NE wind of 10-20 mph will make it feel cooler at times. The high will shift east into the Atlantic tomorrow. This will shift the winds out of the SE and allow warmer air to return Saturday afternoon. An approaching low pressure system will produce increasing clouds on Sunday with a slight chance of showers or t-storms possible by late afternoon into the evening. The best chance of precipitation will be Sunday night into Monday.

Temp: 65F RH: 34%
Winds: NE 10-20 mph

3PM: Mostly sunny and breezy

Winds: NE 10-20 mph

Winds: NE 5-10 shifting SE 10-15 mph
