

Viking Classic 7AM Update Tuesday October 27, 2009



Synopsis:

It will be mostly cloudy today with rain likely throughout the morning with some breaks of rainfall expected for the afternoon as the activity becomes more scattered. High temperatures will only be in the 60s to near 70 degrees. Winds will be out of the east-southeast 6-12 mph. A weak area of high pressure will build in on Wednesday, producing a generally dry day although another slow moving storm system will bring rain and thunderstorms to the region on Thursday and Friday. Dry conditions finally return for the weekend.
