7AM Update Friday October 30, 2009



Synopsis:

It will be mostly cloudy this morning with rainfall expected to move into the region by late this morning and through the afternoon and overnight. Heavy rain will be possible by late tonight with 1-2 inches possible. Temperatures will warm to the upper 70s early and then fall throughout the afternoon once the rainfall moves in. Winds will be out of the southeast turning west-southwest by late this afternoon at 10-20 mph. Rainfall should end by daybreak on Saturday with dry conditions expected for Saturday afternoon and Sunday.

Temp: 70F RH: 65%
Wind: S-SW 7-15 mph gusts 20 mph
