Points per Start

With only one of the eight early season winners teeing it up this week there is an excellent chance that the winner of the Honda Classic will be the ninth different winner. Davis Love III is the highest early season points earner at this week's Honda Classic and with an average of 73.7 points per start he is also the player with the highest points per start average in the field.
