6:30AM Weather Update: Thursday, May 7, 2009



Synopsis: A ridge of high pressure over Central Florida will keep the storm track north across Georgia through the end of the week. Partly cloudy skies and very warm temperatures can be expected each day with highs in the upper 80's. There could be some isolated t-storms during the late afternoon into the evening hours today and again on Friday. But most areas will remain dry through early next week.
