7:30AM Weather Update: Sunday, May 10, 2009



Synopsis: High pressure over Central Florida will keep a cold front over Central and Southern Georgia today. Mainly partly cloudy skies can be expected with highs in the upper 80's at the course and low 90's inland. There could be some isolated t-storms that develop late this afternoon into the evening hours along the sea breeze. Otherwise, the best chance for t-storms will remain north of Jacksonville across Georgia today. The front will move south into Florida on Monday, bringing a better chance for showers and t-storms.
