7:00AM Weather Update: Saturday, May 9, 2009



Synopsis: A ridge of high pressure over Central Florida will provide another sunny and hot day across the area. Highs should warm to around 90 degrees at the course and low to mid 90's inland. The winds will be light during the morning hours and shift out of the SE 10-15 mph by mid afternoon. A cold front will stall across Southern Georgia on Sunday. This may produce some isolated t-storms late in the day. Otherwise, another hot and dry day can be expected.
