7AM Weather Update Thursday May 14, 2009



Synopsis: The stretch of hot and humid conditions will continue for yet another day with today's high expected in the mid 90s. Southeast winds are forecast to increase to 15-25mph by noon and remain gusty through the remainder of the day. There will also be a slight chance of widely scattered pop-up thunderstorms this afternoon. Similar conditions are forecast on Friday with highs in the 90s, gusty southeast winds, and a slight chance of afternoon thunderstorms. Thunderstorm chances will increase a bit over the weekend as a cold front drops into the state. This cold front will bring some temporary relief from the heat by Sunday.
