

Valero Texas Open 7AM Weather Update Friday May 15, 2009



Synopsis: Warm and muggy conditions are expected today with afternoon temps reaching the lower 90s once again. Southeast winds will continue to gust from 15-25mph through much of the day. A stray thunderstorm can not be completely ruled out this afternoon, but chances for rain are slim. A cold front will drop into the state on Saturday and will increase our chances for thunderstorms. There will be a slight chance of thunderstorms during the daytime hours on Saturday with the best chance arriving Saturday night. A few thundershowers may linger into Sunday morning with some clearing expected by Sunday afternoon. Much cooler temperatures are forecast on Sunday.
