7AM Weather Update Saturday May 16, 2009



Synopsis: Mostly cloudy skies are expected this morning with a few showers possible before noon. Thunderstorm chances will increase through the afternoon hours as a cold front approaches from the north. Today's high is forecast to reach the upper 80s with east/southeast winds at 8-15mph. The cold front should push through San Antonio late this evening with thunderstorms becoming likely overnight. A few showers may linger into early Sunday morning with clearing skies by Sunday afternoon. Temperatures will be much cooler on Sunday with afternoon highs only reaching the upper 70s.

8AM: Mostly cloudy with a 20% chance of showers
Temp: 75F RH: 85%
Winds: SE 6-12mph

12PM: Mostly cloudy with a 30% chance of showers and thunderstorms
Temp: 82F RH: 60%
Winds: E/SE 8-15mph

4PM: Mostly cloudy with a 40% chance of showers and thunderstorms
Temp: 87F RH: 45%
Winds: E/SE 8-15mph
