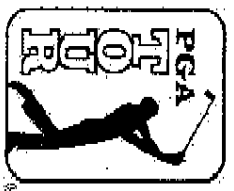

Transitions Championship

7:00AM Weather Update: Thursday, March 19, 2009



Synopsis:

A stalled frontal boundary over Southern Florida will keep the best chances for showers south of Tampa again today. Partly cloudy skies can be expected with highs around 80 degrees. There could be an isolated shower late this afternoon as the sea breeze tries to move on-shore. Otherwise, most areas will remain dry. A dry cold front will move across the state on Friday. This will bring breezy and cooler conditions for the weekend. Highs each day will be in the mid to upper 70's with lows in the mid 50's.

9AM: Mostly sunny.

Temp: 66F RH: 78%
Winds: ENE 5-10 mph

Noon: Mostly sunny.

Temp: 77F RH: 56%
Winds: NE 10 mph

3PM: Partly cloudy with a slight chance of showers.
