

Transitions Championship 7:00AM Weather Update: Friday, March 20, 2009



Synopsis: A cold front over Northern Florida will slowly move south today and should push through Central Florida late this afternoon into the evening hours. This front is moisture starved and should push through the area with just partly cloudy skies. High pressure will build over the Mid-Atlantic States this weekend. This will provide breezy and slightly cooler temperatures for Central Florida. Lows in the mid to upper 50's can be expected each morning with highs warming into the mid to upper 70's.
