7AM Weather Update Thursday April 30, 2009



Synopsis: Partly cloudy and pleasant today with an afternoon high in the upper 70s. East winds at 4-8mph this morning are forecast to shift to the south and increase to 8-15mph by this afternoon. Friday's forecast calls for mostly cloudy skies and breezy conditions. A few isolated showers and thunderstorms will be possible Friday afternoon, but chances to get hit by one will be slight. Rain chances will increase a bit over the weekend as a frontal boundary nears Charlotte, but any showers will be scattered across the area. Temps are expected to remain above normal through the weekend with highs in the lower 80s each day.
