7AM Weather Update Saturday May 2, 2009



Synopsis: A stalled frontal boundary just to our north will remain nearly stationary through the weekend. This front will cause unsettled weather across the area over the next several days. Today's forecast calls for mostly cloudy skies with a chance for scattered pop-up thunderstorms this afternoon. Today's high is expected to reach the lower 80s with southwest winds increasing to 8-15mph. Scattered pop-up thunderstorms will be possible again on Sunday as the front lingers across the state.
