Weather Synopsis

High clouds have begun to stream over Shanghai tonight and they will pretty much stick around over the next couple of days as a trough of low pressure lifts to our north. We could see a few isolated showers develop tomorrow afternoon but the worst of the action should stay to our north. Sunday will be another warm day and we should stay dry but as low pressure begins develop just to our west we could see some showers develop in the afternoon. The main rain event will rapidly develop after sunset and could become quite heavy after midnight and through Monday morning. The rain will taper off by Monday afternoon. Tuesday will be a cooler and drier day with northwest winds.
