7AM Weather Update Saturday March 14, 2009



Synopsis: High pressure has shifted east of the state and the humidity levels have increased somewhat across south Florida today. This slight increase in humidity may support a few stray showers being blown in from the Atlantic later today. Early morning radar shows a few showers up near Palm Beach County with no rain off the coast of Miami. Winds are forecast to be a little bit stronger this afternoon and are forecast to increase out of the southeast at 12-20mph. Today's high is expected in the lower 80s under partly cloudy skies. Warm and humid conditions are forecast on Sunday with afternoon temps climbing into the mid 80s.
